LOCAL ACCOMMODATION TRANSPORT

Lower House Farm is a rural location and we strongly recommend that you book transport well in advance at the time of booking your accommodation. There really are no reliable on-demand taxi services coming from Abergavenny, Hay or Hereford.

Thankfully there is a fantastic local minibus service - J E Private Hire and Minibuses. Jill and Mark operate locally and know the area, accommodation and country lanes extremely well. They can help you organise either a pick up/drop off route or a shuttle bus service back to local accommodation at the end of the wedding.

We recommend that you have a designated "head of transport" for your wedding party. Somebody who can coordinate with J E Private Hire and Minibuses and your party to make the planned routes as efficient as possible, to know who's going where and make sure everybody gets home safely at the end of the day..

If you'e staying with us at Old Great Marlborough, we will cover your transport from Old Great Marlborough to the farm and back on the day of your wedding for up to 22 guests.



LONGTOWN, HEREFORDSHIRE

Green fields stretch out from this little newly-converted barn, and the Black Mountains surge up beyond like a wave on the horizon. Angel Barn makes a perfect base for a small family on holiday, or a get-away for those looking for a romantic break, country air, good food and, perhaps, to investigate the attractions of Hay-on-Wye or Abergavenny.

Angel Barn takes its name from the little statue by the doorway, and this angel would smile more broadly if she could see the interior. A spacious hallway lets light pour in from the roof lights, and creates a feeling of airiness. The living-room is open-plan, with kitchen to one side of the glazed doors, and sitting-area to the other. Upstairs are the two light-filled bedrooms – a master bedroom with a king-size bed, and a twin bedroom.



HAYLOFT, UPPER HOUSE & SPA, CRASWALL










PONTHENDRE FARMHOUSE

Ponthendre Farmhouse is a beautiful seventeenth-century old Welsh farmhouse, lovingly restored, with oak-framed leaded windows, flagstone floors, oak panelling and antique furniture. The house is situated on a quiet country lane near a village in a lush valley at the eastern edge of the Black Mountains with easy access to both the Brecon Beacons and the Wye Valley. The view from the sunny enclosed garden is of a tranquil valley with a tidal wave of dramatic hillsides sloping down towards it.

The big farmhouse kitchen, with an Aga at the heart of it, is a delight. A sunny conservatory leads off this room – superb for warming up winter sunshine, or as a play room for children. The garden is lovely – a good sized lawn, stone terracing, herb and flower beds and swing. A pretty old farm gate leads you into the field, with fruit trees, a pond at the bottom.








RIVERVIEW COTTAGE





The interior of this lovely cottage is wonderfully homely, and has a feeling of spaciousness due to the shape of its rooms. It has a classic country cottage kitchen, complete with a pine table, and some pretty antiques. The sitting-room next door is really cosy, with a wood burner and comfortable furniture. A second adjoining living-room, furnished with a desk and chair and a couple of armchairs, is useful for catching up on some quiet reading, work, or for children to play indoor games. Usefully, this cottage has a downstairs bedroom with a king-size bed - very good for people who don't want to deal with stairs. Upstairs, you will find the master bedroom with a king-size bed, and a pretty room next door with standard twins beds for two adults or two children. Black-out curtains mean that you won't be woken by early summer light.












THE EDWARDIAN SHOWMAN'S WAGON

KAYA AT BLACKHILL FARM, CRASWALL

Getting here is half the fun, driving through narrow country roads, up steep hills and past grazing sheep before being greeted by friendly owners Emily and Malik, whose house adjoins your annex. They are both artists (you'll see their artwork on the walls) and music makers and they've re-wilded the meadow in front of you as well as handbuilt lots of the furniture from bits and bobs they've found on the farm. They love meeting new people but can leave you be to relax and enjoy the peace and quiet of this countryside refuge. You'll find lots of basics in the mini larder, so you don't have to cart absolutely everything from home, along with a generous hamper of homemade and local produce on arrival.

Soak in a double bathtub with more views, cook up a storm outdoors over the fire. On sunny days you'll be swinging in the hanging chair admiring birds (find seeds for the feeder waiting) and listening to the hum of fat bees feasting on the wildflower meadow next to you. If the weather isn't playing ball you can light the wood-burner and have a cosy afternoon in playing board games provided, or with a bit of notice you can have a massage, reflexology, reiki – even a private yoga class. The main thing is to totally wind down in such a beautiful space.

LONGTOWN, HEREFORDSHIRE

Three nature reserves lie within walking distance of this lovely comfortable studio, and the Black Mountains are nearby. Buzzards, hobbies, red kites, and even peregrine falcons fly over the conservation farm where The Sett is situated. Foxes and badgers prowl through the ancient woodland, with tawny oils hunting at night. In summer, kingfishers fly past your window, and you may spot dippers searching for food in the stream. In short, this is a wonderful place for a private mini-break or mini-moon, or a longer holiday to really explore this completely unspoilt and varied landscape.

The Sett is a studio apartment on the first floor of a little detached barn. A staircase takes you up from your own front door to a lobby where you can leave coats. The studio living-room is wonderful – spacious, light-filled and comfortable, with beautiful beams. The bed is a super-king, with a big TV positioned for indulgent in-bed TV-watching. The kitchen is ship-shape in one corner, a comfy sofa in the other, and a round dining-table in the middle.



TRI AFON, LONGTOWN, HEREFORD

Set within the heart of Longtown at the foot of the Black Mountains this detached country home has been beautifully finished offering a great base for family and friends to relax. Well positioned within the heart of the village within walking distance of the local Inn, award winning village store and 12th century Norman Castle. This peaceful part of the National Park offers some of the best walking within the area from your doorstep, explore the Black Mountains and join the Offa's Dyke pathway where you can follow the ridge all the way across to the Hay Bluff.

Step under the oak framed porch to and step inside the entrance hall with wooden floors. A large lounge sits to the side of the hall with sofas that you can simply sink into and relax after a day exploring, with the snug situated to the other side of the hall. The kitchen/diner is the hub of this country home with solid wood farmhouse cupboards and well-equipped with electric oven and hob, microwave, fridge/freezer and dishwasher. There is also a separate WC off the main hallway. Climb the solid wooden staircase to the spacious landing with colourful woollen rugs, you will find three bedrooms. There is a super-king-size with an en-suite shower room with WC enjoying views across to the mountain range. Another super-king-size with an en-suite shower room and WC, and finally a twin zip and link, which can be made into a Super King Size (on request). There is also a bathroom with separate shower and WC on this floor.
